

Green Audit

A work order for the Green Audit of our Institute was signed with Shubhankar Environmental Services on 1st February 2022.

VMSIIHE was determined to follow the best practices in all possible areas including eco-friendly practices. Some of the practices like water harvesting, sewage treatment were planned at the time of establishing the Institute as part of effective management practices. By the time the institute was effectively functional, many of the plans were in existence.

Right from the inception, plans were put in place to ensure that the green cover would be retained and surrounded by greenery like the rest of the village Raia. A visit to Manora Raia will give visitors a picturesque scene of coconut trees, paddy fields, fruit bearing trees and pastoral beauty.

It was decided that a green report should be prepared listing the practices for maintaining ecofriendly measures in a more systematic, objective manner and also to explore the immense possibilities of environmental services that can be offered through and for the stake holders. A committee was formed to ensure that strategies and operations were fulfilled and went beyond mere compliance.

It was concluded that an environmental audit was an absolute necessity because it would take into account environmental diversity, which would lead to a process of identification, quantification and analysis of this diversity. A green audit will empower an Institute to improve its environmental and economic performance by recognizing opportunities to enable development through sustainable practices thereby reducing costs and wastage and boosting the overall environmental quality, health, hygiene and safety.

VMSIIHE invited the Vice-Chancellor of Goa University to inaugurate the auditorium hall and hitech kitchen in the presence of the Director/Principal, Prof. Irfan Mirza along with other dignitaries.







Spread over 528 square meters, the newly inaugurated auditorium has a fully air-conditioned seating area along with well-ventilated corridors, green rooms, and a storage area. Furnished with wooden panelled walls, LED lights, and plush interiors, the hall has a seating capacity for 350 persons.







An ultra-modern kitchen of international standard has been added. The kitchen's unique feature is that it can be configured in a variety of ways to create the ideal training and teaching environment.



Prof. Menon spoke about the infrastructure which would play an integral part in the students' development. He spoke about the high emphasis on practical education and world-class facilities provided by VMSIIHE.

Addressing the faculty and students on the National Education Policy (NEP), he said, "The new policy mandates a shift from teacher-centric to a learner-centric approach. Application-based learning, emotional learning, and a practical application are part of a learner-centric approach. The introduction of the Academic Bank of Credits (ABC) will make it feasible for students to transfer credits and recommended the institute to offer hybrid courses which would support the New Education Policy".





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
