The menu comprised of:

The starter was Semolina Soup. The Semolina Soup Baden Style or "BadischeGriessuppe" which is a delicious and authentic soup specialty from Baden- Würtemberg.

The main course was Rösti (grated raw potato that has been baked with salt and pepper) served with chicken schnitzel and mushroom sauce. Rösti was originally served as a breakfast dish from the Kanton of Bern (capital of Switzerland) which later on became the national dish of Switzerland served as a main course for lunch or dinner.

Dessert was Rueblitorte (Swiss style carrot cake) from the region of Aargau which used to be the main source of carrots for the country. Several versions of "Rüeblitote" abound, Rüebli being the Swiss-German word for carrot.
