Girls draped in stunningly gorgeous ivory white and gold sarees and boys looking handsome, sporting the traditional south Indian mundu,










Traditional dances and songs were performed by the students after lighting the lamp.

Green Sustainable Initiatives

Signing and handing over of the Green Audit Report on 14/9/2022

VMSIIHE has always been at the vanguard of sustainable environmental efforts. Energy and water saving practices were part of the institutional practice. A Green Report was prepared in 2019 listing the practices of the institute for maintaining eco-friendly measures in a more systematic manner.
