Every class was asked to have two models and two designers. Each pair of a model & designer was given a Gender Stereotype. The whole event was carried out into three rounds. Second Round: The models walked with their designers wherein the designers had to describe the costume. Also the judges shortlisted the finalists based on the costume description & the criteria's for judging. Third Round: The shortlisted participants (Models & Designers) had to answer the questions asked by the judges based on Gender Stereotypes.

## Community Extension Programme by VMSIIE
