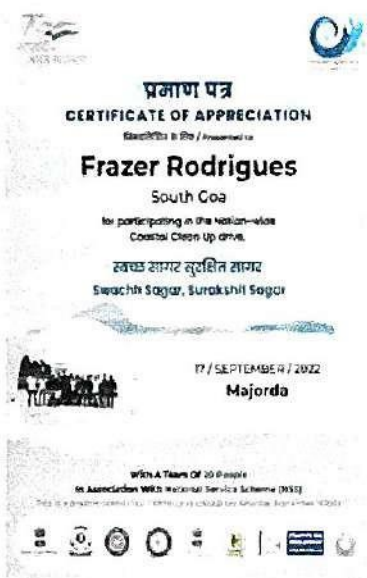

The campaign ended with a group photograph with all the guests and officers. All institutions, organisations and volunteers cleaned 52 beaches across Goa with 5327 volunteers who collected 26161 KG of waste.

National Integration Day 2022


Rangoli Competition
