Report in brief: On 27th September 2023 a heritage walk for hospitality students was organised by SKAL Goa and Goa Tourism in Campal, Panjim. The resource person was Lata Rodrigues a storyteller of the company 'Make It Happen' the manager and learning development of Cidade de Goa and she was assisted by Zaira Fernandes and Shiva.

The resource person introduced the topic to the participants by stating that the intellectual property includes the history of Campal, introducing Kala Academy, renowned artifacts, literary works explaining them in detail. We learnt about many things such as:

Kala Academy, fascinated with marvelous facilities such as lovely auditoriums, both indoor and outdoor. Here lots of activities take place such as dramas, exhibitions, functions, conferences, festivals etc.

Campal this name came from Campo de Dom Manual, Dom Manual de Portugual e Castro a Viceroy, who took over this place in the year 1830 and made the real development making this a commercial from urban. This place actually starts from the end of the Medical College to Campal, this road is now named as Dayanand Bandodkar Marg, after the death of first Chief Minister of Goa. This area is divided into two parts Residential and Commercial. Now the Goa Medical College (GMC) was shifted to Bambolim in 1993 and is one of the Asia's oldest medical colleges.

The First Capital of Goa was Old Goa and then it shifted to Panjim and with this the famous big old cannon in Campal measuring about four meters long was shifted from Old Goa to Panjim, this was guarded by Ismail Adil Khan in the year 1512 in attempting to capture Goa. Then we were taken to the garden where there is a statue of Francisco Luis Gomes built in 1929 the former best of Advocate not only for Goa but for India too, and a representatives in the Cortes, the Lisbon Parliament. Here we were introduced to Evane Picardo who played the Ukulele and sang melodiously.






ORGANIC FARM VISIT
