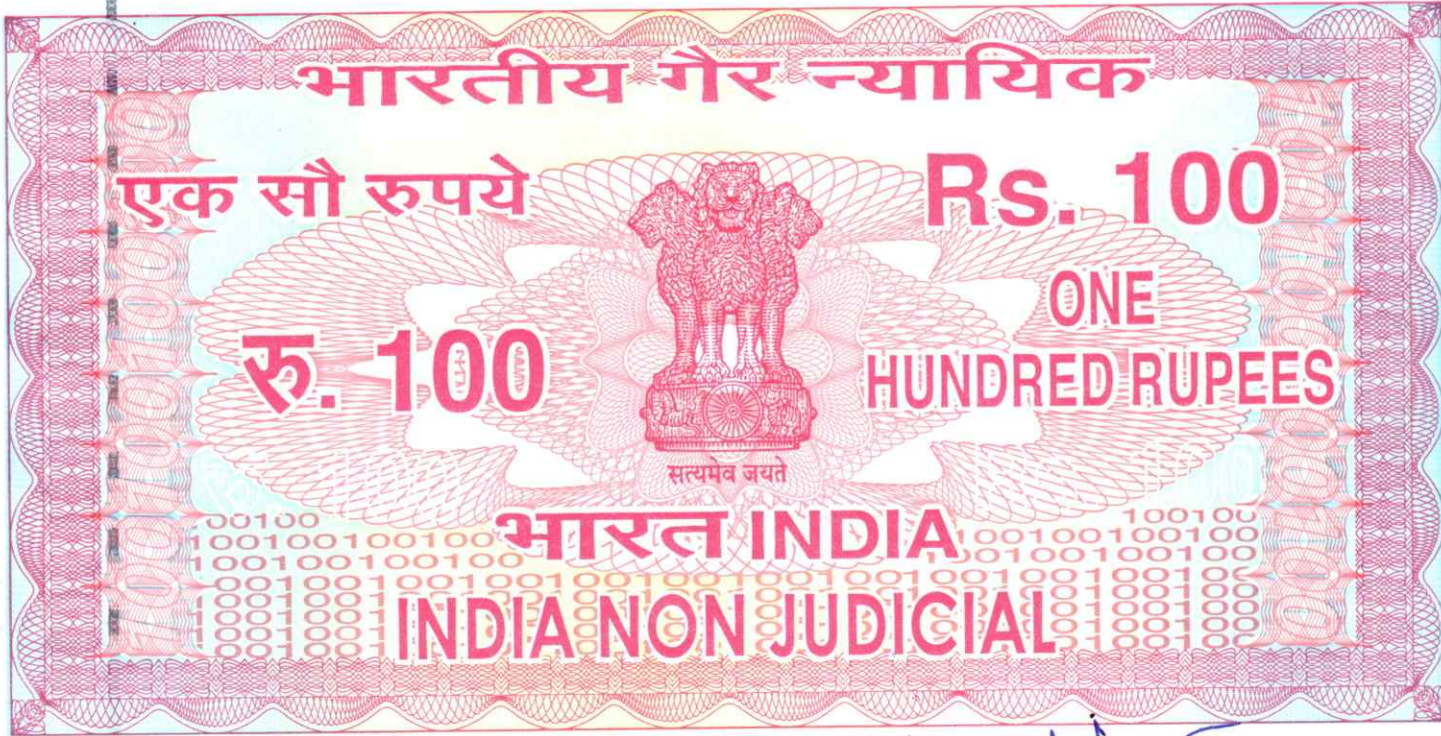

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

BETWEEN

CARMEL COLLEGE OF ARTS, SCIENCE &
COMMERCE FOR WOMEN, NUDEM, GOA



AND

V.M. SALGAOCAR INSTITUTE OF INTERNATIONAL
HOSPITALITY EDUCATION, MANORA, RAIA, GOA



CARMEL COLLEGE OF ARTS, SCIENCE & COMMERCE FOR WOMEN, hereinafter referred to as "**CARMEL COLLEGE**" and represented by Dr. Aldina Braganza e Gomes - Officiating Principal and V.M. SALGAOCAR INSTITUTE OF INTERNATIONAL HOSPITALITY EDUCATION, Goa, hereinafter referred to as "**VMSIHE**", and represented by Prof. Irfan. S. Mirza- Director/Principal, singly referred to as "the Party" and jointly as "the Parties".

OBJECT

The purpose of this Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is to establish a collaborative framework between VMSHIE and Carmel College on various educational and research projects, sharing resources, and enhancing academic and research programs for the progress of the institute, students and teachers in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth in the memorandum of understanding.

The Memorandum of Understanding

NOW, THEREFORE, CARMEL COLLEGE and VMSHIE, hereby do agree to enter into this Memorandum of Understanding on Cooperation between the two Institutes, according to the terms and conditions set out herein under:

1. AREAS OF CO-OPERATION:

- 1.1 The Parties will work together on joint research projects with prior permission of the Representatives of both the institutes in areas of mutual interest.
- 1.2 The Parties will conduct lectures, workshops, seminars, research conferences and similar events as mutually decided for the benefit of students, food industries and the Institutions.
- 1.3 The Party/Parties shall support in providing information regarding the events, conferences and other programs for participation by students and faculty of the institutes.
- 1.4 The Party/Parties shall organise programs in coordination that shall be available to the students of the institutes.

- 1.5 Both parties shall agree to provide access to the library, laboratory facilities and use of equipment to the students of both parties on mutually agreed terms that shall be formulated for each activity or program to be conducted jointly.

2. FIELDS OF COLLABORATION

- 2.1 Collaboration between the two institutions shall be established within the field of Hospitality, Culinary Arts and Food Technology, with the possibility to expand to other fields of joint interest.
- 2.2 The two institutions shall appoint a coordinator to be responsible for regular updates and continuous interaction.

3. FUNDING AND FINANCE

- 3.1 It is recorded that there shall be no consideration payable by either Party for the performance of work or activities described under this MOU, and each Party shall be responsible for procuring its own funding and paying its own costs incurred in respect of such work or activities. In case of external funding, each party shall be responsible for the funds generated or utilised.
- 3.2 Exchanges or field visits under this MOU will, in principle, be organised reciprocally on an honorary basis with no expectation of remuneration.
- 3.3 Research work carried out by either of the parties, which involves funding, has to be discussed and agreed upon by both parties.

4. MANAGEMENT AND ADMINISTRATION

- 4.1 Negotiation, implementation, and reporting on the progress concerning the collaboration shall be coordinated by coordinators as mentioned in clause 2.2.

- 4.2 Issues about specific activities or coordination of activities, including rights and obligations of each party, shall be notified or communicated to the offices mentioned in clause 4.1 above.
- 4.3 This Memorandum shall take effect upon ratification by signature by the Principal of Carmel College and the Director/Principal of VMSHIE.
- 4.4 This MOU shall become effective from the date the parties sign it and shall be valid for three (03) years. Both parties shall review the status of the MOU at the end of the three-year (03) period to determine any necessary modifications. This MOU shall be renewed thereafter for another three years (03) unless either party gives written notice of termination not later than two months before the expiry of the existing MOU.
- 4.5 All joint activities should be completed before the expiration or termination of the MOU.
- 4.6 Either party may terminate this MOU by providing written notice to the other party two months (02) in advance.

5. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

- 5.1 Each Party will be permitted to use the logo of the other Party only for joint activities.
- 5.2 No Party shall acquire any rights, title or interest in the other Party's intellectual property, except the right to use such intellectual property solely and exclusively for the use permitted by the Party in writing. No Party shall use or exploit the other Party's intellectual property for any purpose other than the permitted use.

6. CONFIDENTIALITY

- 6.1 The Parties agree to keep all information arising from or pursuant to, or in the course of performance of the terms of this MOU, secret and confidential (hereinafter referred to as "Confidential Information") and not to disclose such Confidential Information or to permit such Confidential Information to be disclosed to any third party except with the prior written consent of the disclosing Party.

7. SETTLEMENT OF ANY DISPUTES:

- 7.1 Any issues that are not addressed or stipulated in the MOU shall be discussed and resolved through negotiation in good faith. No disputes are foreseen in the implementation of the MOU. The two Parties, however, agree that if any dispute arises between them, efforts will be made to settle the same as amicably as possible.
- 7.2 VMSHIE and Carmel College agree to follow an engagement protocol that is ethical and professional during the delivery of this MOU. Neither of the partners will engage in activities that conflict with government policies/rules, and regulations.
