
Dr. Semele Sardesai, Asst. Prof. - General Management

Malaviya Mission Teacher Training Programme (MMTTP) was conducted online for all Principals and senior staff of colleges in Goa and Gujarat on 8th December 2023. Two hundred ninety six participants attended the same. Dr. Marie Raj and Ms. Shameem Memom participated.

Under MMTTP for orientation and sensitization of faculty members of HEIs on core NEP 2020 themes. To propagate the MMTTP, 111 training centres have been established for teachers attending the training programme. MMTTP will have weightage for NAAC, NIRF, and Career Advancement Scheme (CAS). The MMTTP is mandatory for all teachers, including part time teachers, in all colleges, whether aided/ unaided.
