MERIT-CUM-MEANS SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM FOR UG STUDENTS

Objective:

The basic objective of the Scheme is to support the undergraduate students of V.M. Salgaocar Institute of International Hospitality Education to meet their minor expenses related to their studies.

Amount of Scholarship:

Maximum amount of scholarship to be paid to a student shall be limited to Rs.3000/- per student.

Eligibility

1. Bonafide undergraduate students of V.M. Salgaocar Institute of International Hospitality Education shall be eligible to receive the scholarship.
2. The beneficiary should have cleared his/her qualifying examination in a single attempt.
3. There is no upper limit of family income for applying for the scholarship. However, the Sanctioning Committee shall be guided by the principle of merit-cum-means while selecting the students as the scholarships are limited in number.
4. A student who is in receipt of any other scholarship from Govt. or from any other source shall not be eligible to receive the scholarship.

Funding

The Institute shall create a Scholarship Fund for the purpose of implementing this scheme. The contributions coming from Corporates, NGOs, Alumni, etc. shall be deposited in this fund. Initially the scholarship shall be awarded to maximum of 75% of the students of the Institute. However, from the year 2024-25, it shall be limited to maximum 75% of the first-year students only.

Sanctioning Committee

The Institute shall constitute a Sanctioning Committee headed by the Director of the Institute. Two teachers shall be the members of this Committee. The Accounts Officer of the Institute shall be the Member Secretary of the Sanctioning Committee.

Application Procedure

The Scheme shall be notified to the students in the month of September every year on the College notice board/website. The students shall apply online in a prescribed format attached hereto as an Annexure.

The Management of the Institute shall be the final authority in sanctioning the Scholarship.
